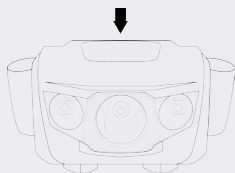

## HOW TO OPERATE

### MAIN MODE

Press once to turn on. Press once to move between settings. Operating modes will activate in the following order:

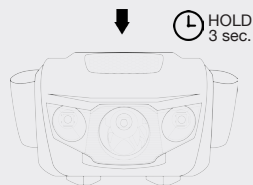


MEDIUM click! HIGH click! LOW click! STROBE

Press again to turn off.

### TWO SIDE LEDs

Press and hold the button for 3 seconds to switch the two side LEDs. Press again to move between the settings. Operating modes will activate in the following order:

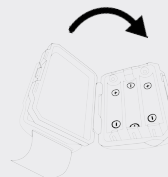


HIGH click! LOW click! STROBE

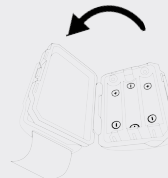
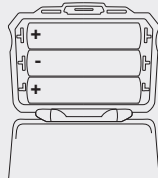
Press again to turn off.

## CHANGING THE BATTERIES

1. Tilt the headtorch.
2. Open the battery compartment.



3. Insert 3 x AAA batteries as indicated on the inside of the battery compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment.



**IMPORTANT:** The battery life will vary depending upon the the brand and freshness of batteries, recovery time - time the light has been switched off, temperature and the setting used.

## DOs AND DON'Ts

- ✓ Use good quality, alkaline AAA batteries.
- ✓ Keep your Viper clean to prevent dirt and dust from entering the electric elements.
- ✓ Remove the straps to wash them separately.
- ✓ Remove any moisture before storage.
- ✓ Have a lot fun while using Viper!
- ✗ **Do not use rechargeable batteries. Using rechargeable batteries may invalidate your warranty.**
- ✗ Do not store Viper with batteries inside for prolonged periods.
- ✗ Do not shine directly into eyes.
- ✗ Do not submerge.
